High Q Award of Merit

This distinguished alumni award recognizes Sweet Home High School graduates who have had an outstanding high school career or are distinguished in their career and in their contributions to society on a local, state and/or national level. Nominations will be accepted by Sweet Home Alumni Foundation High Q committee at any time of the year, however, any received after March 30, will be carried over to the next year. This award is not necessarily given every year.

CRITERIA

Nominees must be able to demonstrate one or more of the following:

- Exceptional accomplishments while in high school in the areas of academics, leadership and extra-curricular activities beyond that of the usual high school student.
- Sustained achievement in their life's work
- Significant contribution in one or more of these areas: Community & Society, Science and Technology, Medicine, Music and the Arts, Athletics, Leadership and Business.
- Outstanding contributions which have had a transformative impact within their community, state or nation
- Recognition on a State, National or International level
- Conditions of Nomination
 - Nominees must be graduates of Sweet Home High School
 - Award is only given once in a lifetime
 - Nominations can be made by alumni, staff, faculty, students or a member of the public.
- All nominations are confidential.
- Alumni may not nominate themselves.

NOMINATIONS

Your nomination package should include the following:

- One completed nomination form
- One page biographical summary of nominee – It is fine to get this information from the nominee if necessary.
- Two letters of support (from other than nominator – typed, 8.5" X 11")
- Additional supporting materials if necessary (supporting materials, no more than six pages, can include nominee's Curriculum Vitae (CV), listing of other awards received, media clippings, etc.)

It may be necessary to move a nomination forward to another year for consideration.

Nominations must be received by March 30 of each year to be considered for that year's award.
